Identifications - Page 3

Addendum to Identification should read:

The only acceptable types of identification for the purchase of spirituous liquor are:

- (1) An unexpired driver's license, from any state, provided it includes a picture of the licensee.
- (2) **An I.D. card from any U.S. state or Canada.**
- (3) An armed forces identification card.
- (4) A valid passport.
- (5) An unexpired Canadian Driver's license with photo.
- (6) An unexpired border crossing identification card with photo and date of birth.
- (7) An unexpired Mexican voter identification card with photo and date of birth. ARS 4-241 (A)

Lawful Hours - Page 4

Addendum to Lawful Hours should read:

The sale of spirituous liquor is allowed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. - 2:00 a.m. **Monday - Sunday**. In an on-sale establishment, customers may consume alcohol until 2:30 a.m. ARS 4-244(15), ARS 4-244(17)

Liquor Questions & Answers - Page 12

Addendum should read:

Q. Is it permissible to carry a firearm in the open or concealed into any premise licensed to sell beverage alcohol?

A. **Yes. A person with a permit who meets the criteria may carry a concealed handgun on the premises of a licensee who is an on-sale retailer unless the licensee posts a sign that clearly prohibits the possession of weapons on the licensed premises.**

Series 06 - Page 23

Addendum

A hotel or motel with a Series 06 license may sell spirituous liquor in sealed containers in individual portions to its registered guests at any time by means of a minibar located in the guest rooms of registered guests. The registered guest must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age. Access to the minibar is by a key or magnetic card device and not furnished to a guest between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. **Monday through Sunday**.

Series 11 - page 30

Addendum

A hotel or motel with a Series 11 license may sell spirituous liquor in sealed containers in individual portions to its registered guests at any time by means of a minibar located in the guest rooms of registered guests. The registered guest must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age. Access to the minibar is by a key or magnetic card device and *not* furnished to a guest between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. **Monday through Sunday**.

Series 12- page 32

Addendum

A restaurant licensee must maintain complete restaurant services continually during the hours of selling and serving of spirituous liquor, until at least 10:00 p.m. daily, if any spirituous liquor is to be sold and served up to **2:00 a.m.**

Unlawful Acts - page 43

Addendum

12. A person with a permit who meets the criteria may carry a concealed handgun on the premises of a licensee who is an on-sale retailer unless the licensee posts a sign that clearly prohibits the possession of weapons on the licensed premises.

Page 47

Unlawful for any retailer:

4. Or employee of a retailer, to sell, deliver or give spirituous liquor to a person between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. **Monday though Sunday**. ARS 4-244 (15).

Page 47

ON-SALE RETAILERS - It is unlawful:

2. For a licensee or employee to allow a person to consume spirituous liquor on the premises between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. **Monday through Sunday**; or allow a person who is not the licensee or employee to possess spirituous liquor in open containers on the premises between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. **Monday through Sunday**. ARS 4-244(17).
